Hello,

Thank you for your interest in riding lessons at The Cutter Farm. All new students begin with a one-hour private evaluation lesson.

The first half-hour is spent on the ground, where the student will learn how to groom the horse, tack up, and safely handle the horse.

During the second half-hour, the student rides while I assess their strengths, areas for improvement, and overall comfort level. This helps me recommend the most appropriate lesson program moving forward. The prices for the lessons when paid weekly are as follows:

1st Evaluation	\$95
Private Hour	\$90
Semi-Private Hour (2 students if eligible)	\$75

We do not take credit cards. Please pay with a check or cash. Lesson days are Tuesday, Wednesday, Friday, Saturday and Sunday. All cancellations require 24-HOUR NOTICE, no shows and same day cancellations pay full price. I am VERY strict about this policy.

For the safety of students, during the lesson you will need to wear appropriate clothing. This includes PANTS ONLY, a flat shoe with a small 1" heel, and a helmet. Helmets are available at the farm for students if needed. Students with long hair MUST have it pulled back in a low ponytail to keep it out of their face. To provide students with a safe, positive experience, I need their undivided attention.

Parents and siblings can be distracting. Do not stand ringside. Children must be quiet and seated so as not to startle the horses. Please leave other animals at home. I also ask that you do not take flash photos without permission. Thank you for your cooperation!
